## General

This is an official voluntary test for young members. It is not compulsory to either take or pass this Test before attempting the D test.

The Test may be taken on or off the lead rein.

## Objective

- To improve and enjoy learning about ponies
- To be happy both on and around ponies
- To know the basic points of the pony

## Riding

- To be able to sit on a pony in halt and at walk
- To be able to hold the reins
- With help, carry out physical exercises such as:
  - Touch parts of the pony, mane, neck, tail etc
- To be able to ride pony away from assessor at walk, turn round a cone and go back to the assessor (can be done on the leading rein).
- To be able to show trot (rising is not necessary) on the leading rein
- To be able to stop at a designated point and say 'thank you'

## Pony Care

- To know the name and colour of the pony they are riding
- To recognise basic parts of pony and tack such as:
  - Saddle
  - Bridle
  - Mane
  - Tail
  - Ears
  - Mouth
  - Legs
  - Hooves
- To be able to feed the pony a carrot correctly.
