## Hosted by Pony Club UK

The 2023 PCIA International Quiz will be hosted by Pony Club United Kingdom and conducted virtually via Zoom.

Date: Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 10pm (UK time)

Teams: Teams are to be made up of four members aged 16 years to 25 years old. All ages will be taken from the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the competition year. If you cannot form a team of 4 but would be able to bring a team of 3, let us know and we will make accommodation to have you participate as well.

Entries: Each country to advise of an intention to participate by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

Team member names required by 10<sup>th</sup> November 2023

Entry fee is £75 per team. PCUK will send invoices and payment details to each team once confirmed if taking part.

## PCIA Online Quiz Rules 2023

Teams need to be accompanied by an independent Team Manager who has access to their own laptop and Wi-Fi with minimum speed of 1.5Mbps.

The for the online quiz to function properly, Team Manager must be comfortable using Google docs and forms.

For ease of communication throughout the Quiz, Team Managers need to join the PCIA team manager's WhatsApp group.

The Team Manager role:

- 1) ensures fair and sporting behaviour of all participants, so preventing cheating
- 2) records answers
- 3) marks those answers
- 4) uploads the scores
- 5) keeps a copy of the answers in case of technical issues.



The Team members:

Each participant will need their own laptop/computer/tablet with access to Wi-Fi of 1.5Mbps and be familiar with using Zoom.

We invite each team to give a short presentation (max 5mins) to share during the competition on what the Pony Club like in their country.

These presentations will be given once the quiz questions are completed and the scores are being finalised.

Participants may login to see the results.

Participation Certificates will be available to download for all team members.

Rosette Certificates will be available to download for Gold, Silver and Bronze winners.

### **Learning Theory**

To include but not limited to, Habituation, Desensitisation, Cognition, Operant Conditioning, Classical Conditioning, and Shaping.

### **Biosecurity**

Principles and good practices.

### **Gastrointestinal System**

To include anatomy, function, health and disease.



### **Mental and Physical Welfare of Equines**

To include but not limited to: 3 F's – friends, freedom, & forage, competition welfare, five domains, five freedoms, pain recognition, stress recognition.

### **Equestrian Music, Art and Film Across the Years**

Horses in history, horses and equestrianism in Film, Music and Art and English language literature.

### **World Class Competition Venues**

Find the name of a World Class Competition Venue by identifying horse and rider combinations who won medals at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

### **General Knowledge (Individual round)**

Equine General Knowledge questions based on a range of subjects from C+ to AH level.
